Alum Creek State Park

43 miles of trails maintained by Delaware County Chapter OHC.

Approximately 25 primitive camp sites with trailhead horse facilities including High lines at each site with firm ground underneath; Potable water for horses; a few shaded sites. Permanent primitive restroom and Port-A-Potties; RV dump station; Potable water; fire rings and picnic tables throughout campground.

Tunnel for horses underneath SR 36/37 on Maple Glen trail; Scenic vistas viewing the lake.

Trail rating: depending on trail, easy to challenging:

Easy – level or gently sloping terrain, consistent groomed surface; wide trail surface; shallow or no water crossings.

Moderate – Rolling to hilly terrain; short steeper slopes; water crossings; irregular trail surface; narrower trail widths.

Challenging – Steeper hills; unimproved trail surfaces, deeper or wider water crossings; boggy areas.
